



## **Reappointment of Dave Kosoof – Board Chair**

Dave is the current Board Chair and has provided steady, thoughtful leadership through a period of significant challenge and change for the organisation. His guidance has been instrumental in strengthening governance practices, including the successful achievement of the Sport NZ Good Governance Mark and the development of the organisation's Strategic Plan through to 2030.

Dave brings a rare balance of deep hockey knowledge, extensive business development experience, and an enduring connection to the Harbour community. A familiar and highly respected face within our Harbour whānau, Dave has been involved in all aspects of Harbour hockey for more than 30 years.

His hockey achievements are outstanding. Dave first represented North Harbour Hockey Association in the Hatch Cup as a 10-year-old and went on to an exceptional international career as a Black Stick from 2000 to 2009, earning 149 caps. He is a two-time Olympian (Athens 2004 and Beijing 2008), a Commonwealth Games medallist, served as Head Coach at the Youth Olympic Games, and was inducted into the Harbour Hockey Hall of Fame in 2019.

Beyond his playing career, Dave has made a significant contribution to the sport as a coach, administrator, and development leader. He has previously worked at NHHA, where he was responsible for all player and coach development, and he currently serves as a member of the Tāmaki Hockey Committee, NZ Māori Hockey rohe delegate, and a Hibiscus Hockey Trustee.

In addition to his sporting credentials, the Board values his whakawhanaungatanga, strategic thinking, and calm, balanced leadership. His commitment to excellence and alignment with our values and vision make him exceptionally well-placed to continue guiding the organisation.
